GRAPE VARIETIES & TERRIORS
Sauvignon Blanc

The Sauternes region, renowned for its sweet wines, benefits from a unique terroir characterized by limestone-rich soils. The region's microclimate, with its warm days and cool nights, allows for optimal grape ripening, resulting in concentrated sugars and intense flavors.

WINEMAKING & AGEING
The grapes for are harvested late, affected by noble rot, concentrating the sugars and flavors. After a gentle pressing, the must is fermented slowly, allowing the development of complex aromas. The resulting wine is aged in oak barrels, during which it undergoes a slow oxidative process, further enhancing its richness and complexity.



KOSHER CERTIFICATION  

This wine is certified under the strict guidance of the Badatz and OU and is kosher for Passover.



RELATED COMMENT
A decadent expression of Bordeaux's sweet wine tradition. The aromas unfurl a captivating medley of ripe apricot, fragrant orange blossom, and a delicate hint of toasted almond. Flavors of rich honey and baked apple dance harmoniously, perfectly balanced by a vibrant acidity that prevents the sweetness from becoming cloying. The Chateau Haut Philippon Moelleux, a sweet white wine from Bordeaux, has been awarded a Gold Medal at the Concours International de Lyon wine competition. It has also received a high rating of 91 points from the prestigious Gilbert & Gaillard Wine Guide.
