The vineyard's elevated position and ample sunshine infuse the wine with a captivating floral bouquet and a zesty, lively finish.

WINEMAKING & AGEING

Gentle pressing extracts juice without excessive tannin extraction. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures preserves fresh fruit aromas. Regular lees stirring enhances mouthfeel and complexity. The final blend is carefully crafted to achieve a harmonious balance of fruit, acidity, and subtle minerality. Six months in stainless steel tanks maintain freshness and preserve delicate aromas.



KOSHER CERTIFICATION



This wine is certified under the strict guidance of the Badatz and OU and is kosher for Passover.

The Chateau Haut Philippon Rose delights the senses with vibrant flavors of strawberries, raspberries, and grapefruit.
